TERM OF OFFICE

The President may serve one (1) two (2) year term, with the option to renew for an additional two (2) terms, to serve a maximum of six (6) years, concurrent with the fiscal year (June 1st to May 31st). There are no term limits for the Vice President/President-Elect, Immediate Past-President, Secretary, Treasurer, P.R.I.D.E. Program Chairs, and Executive Board at Large Members, however the 'Canes Community should continuously look for new volunteers to serve in leadership roles.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS –

'CANES COMMUNITY PRESIDENT AND VICE PRESIDENT/PRESIDENT-ELECT

All 'Canes Community Presidents and Vice Presidents/President-Elects must meet the following criteria:

- Be an alumnus/alumna from the University of Miami.
- Make an annual “stretch” gift to the University of Miami.

**Please note that all other 'Canes Community Executive Board positions are open to any constituents (including non-alumni). It is recommended that all constituents serving in a 'Canes Community Executive Board position make an annual “stretch” gift to the University of Miami, however this is only required for the President and Vice President/President-Elect positions.*

RELEASE FROM DUTIES

All 'Canes Community Executive Board officers are subject to release from duties by the UM Alumni Association for non-compliance with UM Alumni Association Constitution & Bylaws, and/or the 'Canes Community Best Practices. 'Canes Community Executive Board officers who engage in behavior and/or activities that do not represent the University of Miami in a positive and professional manner are also subject to release from duties at the discretion of the UM Alumni Association Regional Engagement Team.
