David Mullings is chairman and CEO of Blue Mahoe Holdings, Inc., a private investment firm focused on affordable housing and asset management with a strong Caribbean focus. As an entrepreneur, he credits his tenacity, competitiveness, and drive to the discipline of his early roots in Jamaica.
